The Pakistan (Indian Independence Legal Proceedings) Order, 1948.

No. G. G. O. 21.—Whereas in the exercise of powers conferred by section 9 of the Indian Independence Act, 1947, and of all other powers enabling him in

that behalf, the Governor-General was pleased to make the Indian Independence (Legal Proceedings) Order, 1947;

And whereas sub-section (3) of section 9 of the Act provides that any order made under that section may be made so as to be retrospective to any date earlier than the third day of June 1947;

Now, therefore, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him as aforesaid and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor-General is pleased to make the following Order :—

1. (1) This order may be called the Pakistan (Indian Independence (Legal Proceedings) Order, 1948.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the fifteenth day of August, 1947.

2. No judgment, decree, order or sentence referred to in paragraph 3 of Article 4 of the Indian Independence (Legal Proceedings) Order, 1947, shall affect the legislative or executive right or authority of the Central or any Provincial Government of Pakistan where such right or authority has been at issue; and no judgment, decree, order or sentence shall be inoperative subject to any decision that may be obtained from a competent court of the Province concerned.
